## **Natural Resources Wales' first Open Call for projects under the new Commissioning Approach – External Stakeholder Events**

Over the past year, NRW has been developing a new commissioning approach to identify the challenges, as set out in the Natural Resource Plan, the State of Natural Resources Report (SONARR) and Area and Wellbeing statements, that we need to work in collaboration to address.

As part of this approach, funding and other support will be allocated to challenges in each of the areas covered by Wales' Area Statements and to actions that are best delivered once for Wales.

We are holding a series of events to introduce the challenges and launch a call for expressions of interest.
